What will I learn on this course?

Learn how to make different types of pastries, including savoury pies and desserts. Also, learn how to cover and decorate a fruit cake ready for the Christmas season and make sponge cakes of different flavours.

By the end of the course, you will be able to:

- Use different types of pastries.
- Make a savoury dish.
- Make different pasties or pies.
- Make the fillings for pasties or pies.
- Cover a fruit cake with marzipan.
- Decorate a Christmas cake.
- Learn how to make a sponge cake and identify when it is cooked and what to look out for.
- Make cupcakes and decorate them.
