What will I learn on this course?

This course is suitable for complete beginners as well as learners with some previous experience in garment making.

You will learn how to:

1. Operate a sewing machine and overlocker safely and effectively
2. Cut and prepare fabric accurately using commercial patterns
3. Design, create, and adapt patterns, including tracing from original templates
4. Construct your own garments, such as pyjama tops and bottoms
5. Apply embroidery techniques using a sewing machine
6. Interpret and follow more complex patterns (for more advanced learners)

You will also be encouraged to personalise, adapt, and design your own creative work.

Additional information

- You can work on your own chosen projects, with support and guidance from your tutor.
- If you are new, you will begin by learning how to use different sewing machine stitches and accessories.
- You will receive practical advice on using commercial patterns, including how to adjust them to create a garment that fits you well.
- Throughout the course, you will learn about and explore:
 - Choosing the right fabrics and materials (haberdashery)
 - Different construction methods
 - A range of sewing techniques, demonstrated step-by-step

She has completed a BTEC National diploma in fashion and textiles which taught pattern cutting and how to make garments for adults and children. She has experience in textile printing, and on using an embroidery machine to make cushions and quilting. In addition, Tracey works within the wellbeing programme and is doing her doctorate in Art and its therapeutic benefits to mental health.

What will I need to provide myself?

A basic sewing kit including tape measure, pins and scissors and suitable sewing thread. Your tutor will discuss possible projects, sewing kit, fabrics and patterns at the first class. If you already have a project planned, please bring fabric and your pattern to the first class. A note pad and pen may also be useful.

Please check that the class is running before buying anything.

What could I do next?

This course can help you take your first steps towards a range of jobs in the textiles and fashion industry such as machining, alterations specialist, fashion designer or costume maker. Your tutor will be able to advise on the options available to you in their subject.
