What will I learn on this course?

This course is suitable for people with some knowledge of Spanish or those who have completed a Year 1 in Spanish course or GCSE-Level in Spanish fairly recently. You may have knowledge of other languages (Italian, French, Portuguese, for example or perhaps have lived in Spain. At this point, the Present simple will have been covered (*I work: trabajo, You do: haces, I eat: como, etc.*).

This course hopes to create a better understanding of Spanish culture and to give you the skills to interact with Spanish people in everyday situations. It will be relaxed and enjoyable and you will spend most of the time speaking, listening, reading and writing. We are following a Coursebook (Pasos 1) that includes all the content for Year 1 and Year 2, so you will be able to revise and go back to previous content if needed.

Spanish Year 2 course objectives:

- Can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of relevance (e.g. basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment).
- Can describe in simple terms aspects of your background, immediate environment and matters of immediate need.
- Can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.
- Can deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the language is spoken.
- Can produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest in present, future and past tense.
- Can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes and ambitions and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.

Tenses covered in Year 2: Present, present continuous, immediate future, future simple and an introduction of conditional and past tenses.
